From the Pastor's Desk

Psalm 199:33-40: Teach me, O Lord, the way of your statutes, and I will observe it to the end. Give me understanding, that I may keep your law and observe it with my whole heart. Lead me in the path of your commandments, for I delight in it. Turn my heart to your decrees, and not to selfish gain. Turn my eyes from looking at vanities; give me life in your ways. Confirm to your servant your promise, which is for those who fear you. Turn away the disgrace that I dread, for your ordinances are good. See, I have longed for your precepts; in your righteousness give me life.

Dear members and friends of the Red Hook UMC,

On February 5, 2017, the leaders and trustees of our church met with our District Superintendent, Rev. Betsy Ott, and me to learn about an exciting opportunity in the life of the church.

The Rhinebeck UMC, as many of you know, has been in severe decline for several years. Membership and financial resources at the Rhinebeck UMC have reached critically low levels. In response to these realities, the Rhinebeck congregation voted on a motion in December 2016 to seek to merge with another UMC congregation in the geographic vicinity. As part of this merger, the Rhinebeck UMC will no longer be an independent entity. All assets and liabilities, both financial and property, will be transferred to the receiving church in the merger.

Additionally, the New York Annual Conference has pinpointed the Rhinebeck area as being an ideal place to spearhead a new church. I will be leading this effort as a church-planting pastor. Therefore, the merging church assuming claim over the property and finances of the Rhinebeck church will also be supporting this new church initiative. Financial and programmatic assistance for the new church will come from the Conference office of David Gilmore, Director of Congregational Development and Revitalization. This will include funds for both pastoral and mission support.

Under the wording of this motion, DS Ott has the authority to seek a potential merger partner in nearby UMCs. This invitation to merge has been offered first to the Red Hook UMC. DS Ott has asked our Red Hook trustees to respond to this offer in the coming weeks. If we at Red Hook decide for the merger, DS Ott will walk us through the process by which we officially vote for it and then negotiate all terms with the Rhinebeck congregation, with a merge target date of July 1st, 2017. If we decide against the merger, DS Ott will need time to pursue other potential partners in timely fashion. To this end, our leaders and trustees have already begun a process of reviewing financial documents and have taken a complete walking tour of the Rhinebeck UMC property.

Red Hook trustees and leaders have made it clear that they wish to gather input from all interested members of the congregation on this matter before making a final decision. To that end, everyone is invited to attend our upcoming *combined* Trustees and Council meeting on on Sunday, March 12th at 1pm. The merger proposal will be a central discussion item at both of these meetings, and this is your chance to be involved in the decision-making process.

In the meantime, I am certain that many of you have questions and concerns. I ask that we all work together to maintain both an open and honest dialogue about the proposal. I also ask that we include persistent prayer

for discernment in our evaluations and discussions. We need to make a decision based on what we discern God is calling us to do.

My goal as your pastor is to answer your questions to the best of my ability, facilitate communication between all parties, and to make sure our discernment process is both timely and substantial, so that we make the best decision as led by God for our congregation. I also encourage you to talk to our leaders, including the trustees (led by Mark Chenkus, chairperson) and Council (led by Lois Chenkus, chairperson).

Let us be open and discerning about the Spirit's movement as we make this important decision. In Psalm 119, a portion of which is printed above, the psalmist cries out to God for guidance in following God's will. Please join me in praying this Psalm as together we search for God's direction for the Red Hook UMC.


